Criteria & Targets	The goal is for 75% of students to achieve intermediate mid proficiency (a score of 5 or higher) on the speaking section of STAMP test in SPAN 370.	
Results & Conclusion	Results: 80% passed.  Conclusions: We find that the test is an accurte picture of students' abilities; however, the program is growing, and thus with a larger sample size anticipated for the fall (N=15), we will have more data from which to make pedagogical decisions. Writing presents the most challenges for our students, so the current results give us reason to be optimistic.	
**IMPORTANT - Plans for Next Assessment Cycle:	Organizing and administering the STAMP has been cumbersome. We've had to send students to the testing center, which present significant logical challenges. Therefore, we have spoken with the AVANT company—the company which administers the STAMP—and they have remote proctoring, which provides more flexibility. Since writing is the most challenging portion of the test, taking the exam in a comfortable setting may lessen anxiety and improve results.
